



## 4-H VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY MODEL ROCKET LAUNCH FOR DISABLED YOUTH



The Disability Action Center (DAC) in Redding is holding a free model rocket launch for disabled youth. The event will take place on Wednesday, April 7 from 10:00 am to noon at Big League Dreams sports park in Redding. This is the week of spring break for most students.

Four to six volunteers are needed to assist with the event. Some of the needed tasks are:

- Retrieving rockets after launch
- Rocket technician, who helps the leader prepare and launch the rockets
- Photo and video takers
- Data takers
- Assist with activities, such as stomp rockets
- Assist with setup and takedown

Volunteers would learn about model rockets, including how they work and their capabilities. A training session, including a rocket launch, would be held for those volunteers who want one. This would occur a few days prior to event. Volunteers would need to provide their own transportation to and from the event.
