Heading east from I-5 on main street in Williams take a left on 9th street (becomes Zumwalt). Continue on 9th Street for 2 miles and then right onto Walnut street. Continue on Walnut street for 6.3 miles and turn left on Spring Valley road. The ranch is 7 miles down Spring Valley road on the left. The entrance gate is the last gate before you enter the Wintun Indian Reservation's Cortina Rancheria. Watch for the signs.
